Agenda

- 1) St Barbara Atlantic Operations - Welcome, Introductions and Land Acknowledgment
JA welcomed the members to the meeting and provided a land acknowledgment. JA also introduced SP as a guest to the meeting.
- 2) CLC Chair - Review and approval of previous meeting minutes from January 2024
MG motioned that the minutes be approved, and BP seconded, although the minutes will be circulated to GL and RD for review (quorum).
- 3) CLC members reviewed outstanding action items.
- 4) Review of Mooseland Information Session.
CLC members brought forward some of the feedback from the info session, including BP and MG noting that the flow charts were hard to follow. JT mentioned that he had heard from multiple attendees that they were concerned about how the Closed-loop hydro and solar panels would affect reclamation. JA said she had a conversation with a gentleman who was concerned about the restoration of trails that were severed or rerouted during mine operations. MG asked about the barricaded viewing platform, to which AT replied there will be some construction inside the barricades shortly.
- 5) Operational, Community and Mooseland Exploration update provided by St Barbara Atlantic Operations.
JT provided CLC members with a community update, highlighting the Sheet Harbour Marina Community Partnership Agreement and the extension of the Mooseland and Area Community Association CPA.



AT provided CLC members with an operations update, stating that the water management and environmental team are still carrying on with their monitoring. Reclamation activities are being carried out on the south side of the TMF (re-sloping), the operations team are “regreening” some areas inside site, including the exploration and admin parking areas, continue to re-slope the bottom tier (10m) of the Waste Rock Storage. The operations team have been looking into the removal of some of the buildings (security shack). JT asked AT if there would be an opportunity for recycling or salvaging leftover items from the buildings and he ensured that SB would make surplus items available.

The CLC was provided a brief update on the 15-Mile Project, SB’s Simberi Project and recent Cochrane Hill drilling program results.

JT provided CLC members with a Mooseland Exploration update, stating that there will not be any activity on Mooseland proper, and that the exploration team had recently completed some non disturbance claim maintenance activities on the Mooseland north claims, on crown land parcels.

6) New Business

BP mentioned that it would be important to find another member for the CLC, and SP (attending as guest) was nominated to become a member. The attending CLC members (BP and MG) agreed that he should be made a member. The meeting attendees reviewed the Terms of Reference, and noted that he could be voted in.

JT stated that this is the last meeting to be held at the Enterprisers Hall, as SB will not be renewing the lease. The next CLC meeting is tentatively scheduled to be held at the Mooseland Community Centre.

JT inquired about upcoming summer festivals and activities that will take place in the community. The CLC noted that the Mooseland Fun Days will occur July 27-28, 2024. Other activities identified include Canada Day events at Lake Charlotte and potentially at Memory Lane.
